

## Hand-over Books

The following three books are easy to make and fun for the children to share. Each little-book story has a main character that peaks back at the reader from the rear of the book while his hands grasp the book from the front.

Staple, or use notebook rings, to hold the book pages together.

Use scissors on the dotted lines to cut out the pieces. After all the pieces are cut out, glue the head of the main character to the last page of the book, as shown.
