

Underwater Viewer Toy Tote

Bag Contents: A coffee can with a plastic lid, small sheet of clear-plastic wrap, and a rubber band.

1. Make an Underwater Viewer.



2. Remove the bottom of the can with a can opener.



3. Flatten the sharp and rough edges on the inside of the can with pliers.



4. Cover one end of the can with the clear-plastic wrap; hold the wrap in place with the rubber band and keep out the water.



5. Cut out the center of the plastic lid leaving about a half-inch border all around. Put the lid over the plastic wrap, on the end of the can, to hold the wrap in place.



6. Your child uses the viewer to look underwater in the bath tub, an aquarium, or a puddle of water.
